The 12 consecutive hours on duty requirement contained in 49 C.F.R. 395.8 (L)(1)(ii) shall not apply to intrastate drivers of commercial motor vehicles described in section 2v(2)(b), (d), and (e) who return to the work reporting location, and are released from work within 15 consecutive hours of being on duty.
